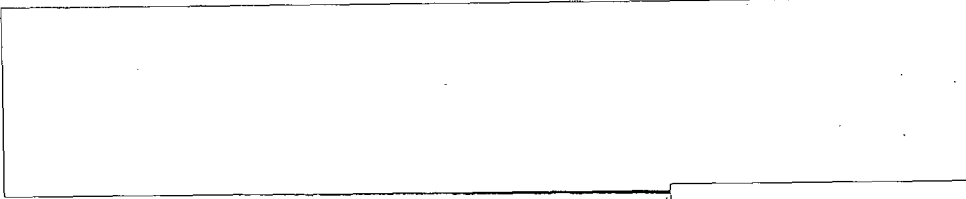
This report is a translation from Russian of a Soviet document classified SECRET entitled Extract of the Call Signs of Communications Centers and Government Communications Stations for Exercise "ZAPAD [West]-77" (For the First Front, Operations Group of the General Staff of the Polish Armed Forces, and Navy of the Polish People's Republic). The document, which was published in Moscow in early 1977, gives rules for placing telephone calls through secure and high frequency long-distance communications channels and lists the call signs to be used for Exercise "ZAPAD [West]-77" by the exercise directors and participating army, navy, and air force staffs, command posts, and control posts of the Czechoslovak, GDR, Polish, and USSR armed forces.

RULES

FOR PLACING TELEPHONE CALLS OVER LONG-DISTANCE
COMMUNICATIONS CHANNELS

1. Placing telephone calls with responsible persons of staffs and control posts over secure communications and high frequency government communications is accomplished as follows:

[REDACTED] -- with subscribers of secure communications stations-- by using the call sign of the communications center and the telephone number ~~of~~ surname of the subscriber;

-- with subscribers of high frequency government communications stations--by using the call sign of the government communications station (or using the name of the city) and the telephone number or surname of the subscriber.

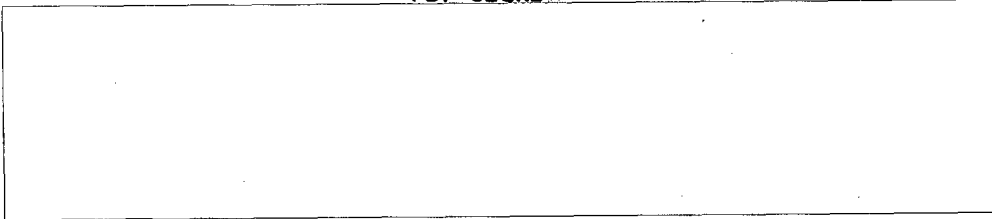
Connecting secure communications subscribers and also high frequency government communications subscribers of the same station among themselves is not done.

2. When control posts (command posts, rear services control posts) are relocated, the communications center of the first position uses the call sign given to it without an index, the second position uses index 5 until control is transferred to it. (For example: at the first position the call sign is used without an index--"Parmir"; at the second position, it is "Pamir-5").
