- 1. In compliance with para. 4 b. of reference, the following results of the SR Division review of AEACRE functions is submitted.
- 2. In view of the recently announced reassignments of several of the very top division personnel, the SR review of the possibilities of redirection and expansion of DOB (AEACRE) functions has moved slowly and will not be finalized for several months. For the present, the primary DOB functions and level of activities will continue as described in the Project Amendment No. 2 for FY 1954. It is therefore requested that the 50 on-board ceiling be waived in order that personnel assignments may be permitted to come into balance with the currently approved ceilings of safehouses, motor vehicles, supplies, equipment, safehousekeepers and budget. Both the budget and T/O of 60 personnel are based on those items required to support 7 REDSOX training projects at one time.
- 3. DOB has considered using its facility to train certain Caucasian black penetration agents. Last month an agent under an SE project was trained at a DOB facility in conjunction with OTR staff and instructors. Such cooperation will continue so long as the precedence of REDSOX training will permit. However, no provisions for additional personnel, money nor equipment have been included in AEACRE for this purpose.
