A. The following contract individuals are presently in the employ of SR/DOB:

1. John H. REINGEWIRTZ (P)

REINGEWIRTZ was contracted by the SR Division on 5 January 1953, and possesses CSC #C 12562 #77437 dated 23 October 1952 for use as a contract instructor. REINGEWIRTZ is 30 years old and was born in Ushgorod, Czechoslovakia, on 2 July 1925. He is married and a naturalized citizen. He attended the University of Munich for two years (1945-1947) and graduated from Southern Florida College in 1948. Subject speaks Russian, Czechoslovakian, German, Hungarian and English. Although he has had no previous intelligence background, he has received Agency training and has three years SR Division experience as a translator and Russian language instructor for both staff and agent personnel. REINGEWIRTZ is currently employed as an agent trainer, translator, and language instructor, at a salary of \$5,000 per annum.

2. John T. GOADUNSTON (P)

GOADUNSTON was first contracted by the SR Division on 26 September 1951, for the CAPSTAN/AEONIAN project as an instructor of covert agents. He possesses CSC P 2-787 #50908 dated 19 May 1952 and amended 30 September 1954. Subject was born on 25 June 1909 in Majoriskai, Vilkauskis, Lithuania. He is a naturalized citizen, married and has one son. GOADUNSTON completed the Lithuanian military academy in 1930 and was commissioned a Junior Lieutenant in the Lithuanian Army. During the period 1937-1940, he served as a Senior Lieutenant in the Lithuanian Army Intelligence Service and was subsequently made Chief of the Vilnius Branch of G-2 gathering information on the Soviet Union. Upon the Soviet occupation of Lithuania subject was dismissed from the Lithuanian Army and was in hiding for a year until the beginning of the German occupation. During the German occupation, he worked in the Directorate of Justice and simultaneously was in contact with the Lithuanian anti-Nazi forces. Subject is fluent in Lithuanian, Russian, Polish and English. At present, he is employed as a general consultant, agent trainer, research analyst, translator and language instructor at a salary of \$5,600 per annum.

3. Robert J. FLUDE (P)

FLUDE possesses CSC P 2-788 #51268 dated 30 June 1951, and amended 6 October 1954. He was first contracted by the SR Division on 12 July 1951 as an agent trainer, general consultant, and translator and now earns a salary of

\$5,600 per annum. He was born on 3 March 1912 in Shaigirai, Lithuania, he is married and has one daughter. His religion is Roman Catholic. He graduated in 1931 from the Lithuanian Army College with a rank of Junior Lieutenant and served in the Lithuanian Army from 1931 to 1940 during which time he attended General Staff School for three years. Subject was promoted to Senior Lieutenant in 1935 and to Captain in 1939. In 1940 when the Soviets absorbed the Lithuanian Army, subject deserted and joined the Wehrmacht, where he was assigned to the Operations Section, G-2 Division of the Königsberg Military Region. During this period subject also made contact with the Lithuanian underground. Subject attended a Wehrmacht Secret Intelligence School and upon completion served as a reconnaissance officer and later as an intelligence officer on a division staff. He was wounded in 1945 in Berlin, captured by the Americans, and turned over to the British. Subject was released in 1946 and worked for the U.S. Army Intelligence for a period of three years. He is fluent in English, Lithuanian, German, Russian and Polish.

4. Mario K. GIORDANO (P)

GIORDANO possesses CSC JG 3721 #50562 dated 12 January 1953, and amended 6 October 1954. He was contracted by the SR Division on 5 September 1951 as a general consultant, translator, and instructor. Subject was born on 13 September 1904, in Kuressaare, Estonia, and is married and has two children. He is an alien and will be eligible for citizenship in 1963. GIORDANO worked for Estonian intelligence from 1929 to 1940, fleeing to Germany upon the Soviet occupation of Estonia. He worked for the German Abwehr from June 1941 to late 1943. In 1944 he returned to Estonia on an intelligence mission and in May 1945 he surrendered to the British who interned him. Subject was soon released and lived in British territory for several years. Later he returned to Germany where he was contacted by this organization. He speaks Estonian, Russian, German, English and some French and Finnish. Subject is presently employed as agent trainer, consultant and language instructor at a salary of \$5,600 per annum.

5. Patrick B. NEWENS (P)

NEWENS possesses CSC PZ 3265, file #28635 dated 29 July 1952, amended 8 November 1954, and was born on 4 September 1920, in Reval, Estonia. He worked for SSW of OSO in Germany during the period 1946-1951. He has had Agency training and is presently employed as an agent trainer and general consultant at a salary of \$5,400 per annum. Subject has first papers and will receive his citizenship in 1956. Subject is married and has one child. NEWENS speaks

fluent Estonian, Russian, German and English and some French, Italian and Dutch. He finished college in Switzerland and received a BS Degree as a textile engineer. NEWENS was drafted into the Soviet Army in July 1941 and was later interned in Siberia as a "politically unreliable individual". He escaped and was later drafted into the "Estonian Division" where he was wounded and taken prisoner by the Germans. He was picked up by this Agency in Germany and worked for CSO as stated above.

6. Alexander ROUZITSKI (P)

ROUZITSKI possesses CSC C #14566 file number 40733, dated 22 October 1954. He was born on 3 October 1897 in the village of Shipilov, Leningrad Oblast. He was first contracted by the SR Division on 29 March 1951, having previously worked for this Agency overseas. He has a common-law wife and two children. Subject is an alien who will be eligible for naturalization in 1962. He is fluent in Russian, Ukrainian, and German and reads some English. He has a law degree from Leningrad University and served in the Soviet Army from March 1919 to August 1921 and April 1924 to 1926. In August 1934 subject was admitted to the NKVD and remained with them until his defection in March 1948. Subject was working for this organization prior to his defection. ROUZITSKI is now employed as interrogator, research analyst and agent trainer at a salary of \$6,000 per annum.

7. Mary I. SCARVILLE (P)

Subject, who possesses CSC #C 19457, file number 90529 dated 18 June 1953, was born on 12 September 1909 in Korsakiskis, Lithuania. She is the wife of John P. GOADUNSTON (P). Subject was contracted by the SR Division on 11 June 1953, and became a naturalized citizen on 10 August 1954. She speaks, reads and types Russian, German, Lithuanian and English and speaks fair Polish. She graduated from the University at Kaunas in 1934, having majored in Economics. She is presently employed as a typist and translator at a salary of \$3,700 per annum.

8. Curtis A. LENOIRD (P)

LENOIRD, who possesses CSC #JG 2624, file number 47130 dated 6 May 1952, and amended 22 October 1954, was first contracted by the SR Division on 22 December 1951. Subject is stateless and will be eligible for naturalization in 1957. He was born 17 February 1907 in Chestakhev which was a small village in pre-revolutionary Russia and is now a portion of Latvia. He graduated from the University of Riga in 1935.

From 1940 to 1944 he worked in Estonia, entering Germany in 1944 as a political refugee. Subject worked in Germany until 1949 when he became an instructor in the USAREUR Intelligence School where he was contracted by this organization. He speaks fluent Russian, English, Latvian, French and German. He is now employed as an agent trainer and general consultant at a salary of \$5,600 per annum.

B. In addition to the above-mentioned individuals, the following safehousekeepers are employed in the various DOB safehouses:

Subjects are contract employees working as safehousekeepers for SR Division. They were contracted 10 March 1954 and are now employed at a salary of \$3,600 per annum and expenses. They possess CSC #25095 #96723 dated 26 January 1954, and are married and have two children. Janie L. CRATCH was born 13 July 1912, in Pitt County, N. C. She completed high school and speaks only English. Geoffrey A. CRATCH was born on 28 August 1905 in Beaufort County, N. C. He has a high school education and speaks only English. He has had no prior military service. This couple is presently employed at DOB safehouse #24, at a salary of \$300 per month plus expenses.

Subjects possess CSC #C 15941 File #81530 dated 2 March 1953. Subjects are married and have no children. Frank KOVAL is a Staff Sergeant on active Air Force duty. He is knowledgeable of CIA employment. He was born on 22 February 1920 in Northampton, Pa. He completed elementary school and speaks Ukrainian and English. Sgt. KOVAL entered the U.S. Air Force in September 1940. Marguerite KOVAL was born on 24 January 1927 in Allentown, Pa. She has a high school education and speaks English and has a slight knowledge of German. Subjects were first contracted by the SR Division in January 1953, and are currently employed as safehousekeepers for DOB safehouse #21.

3. [] and []

Subjects possess CSC's #PZ 2662 file #68021 and PZ 2663 #68022, respectively. They are married and have no children. Logan PHILLIPS was born on 17 September 1917 in Gaffney, S. C. He completed the 7th grade of school and served in an enlisted grade in the U.S. Air Force from September 1943 to May 1947. Allie PHILLIPS was born on 30 January 1911 in Lexington, N. C. She finished the 8th grade of school. This couple is currently employed as safehousekeepers for DOB safehouse #22 at a salary of \$325 per month and expenses.

Subjects possess CSC's #C 25221 #96765 and C 25220 #96780, respectively, dated 10 February 1954. Henry WYNNE was born in Henderson, N. C., on 18 May 1911. He completed the 5th grade, and was a Sergeant in the Army from April 1941 to September 1943. Catheline WYNNE was born in Hertford County, N. C., on 7 February 1908. She completed high school. Subject couple was contacted by SR Division on 5 February 1954, and are currently employed as safehousekeepers in DOB safehouse #27 at a salary of \$300 per month and expenses.

G. The following individual is employed by DOB as a spotter for potential REDSOX agent candidates in Sao Paulo, Brazil:

1. Carlos FRANCOS (P)

Subject possesses Operational Clearance #7123 dated 23 October 1953, and was contracted by SR Division on 1 February 1954. FRANCOS was born on 13 June 1931 in Kharkoo, Ukraine. He is stateless, unmarried, and has the equivalent of a high school education. He is fluent in Ukrainian, Russian and Portuguese and speaks fair English. He is of the Ukrainian Orthodox religion and has had no military experience. He has been engaged in spotting activities for the Agency since 1954, and is currently operating outside of the U.S. as a spotter for the SR Division. He receives a salary of approximately \$85 or five thousand Cruzeiros per month.

D. The following contract personnel are being considered for employment with SR/DOB as agent spotters or instructors:

1. ABHUNTER h

Subject, who is being considered for use by SR Division as a part-time unpaid spotter of prospective REDSOX agents, is currently undergoing assessment. He was born in Krasnodar, USSR, on 12 December 1923. Subject is married, a naturalized U.S. citizen and has had no previous military or intelligence experience. Subject possesses Provisional Operational Clearance #C-38616 dated 5 August 1955. A Covert Security Approval was requested for this individual on 12 September 1955.

2. ROVER 1, an Armenian-Russian area specialist now employed in Turkey.

3. BECAVAN, a Great Russian area specialist now employed in Germany.
