MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, SR Division

SUBJECT : Request for Amendment #1 to Project AEACRE for the Fiscal Year 1960

REFERENCES : Project AEACRE Renewal for FY 1960 approved 11 August 1959; Regulation 20-250 Revised 14 November 1958, paragraph 2, Definitions - Sub. d (3).

1. The current Project AEACRE Renewal carries a Budget Provision under 17.1 Category - Salaries of Contract Agents - for 6 trainer, interpreter, etc. types in the SR/DOB training program. Presently this group is under strength and it is proposed that the following named individual be employed in one of the trainer slots indicated:

Capt., Inf., USAR, is about to be retired after completion of 20 years of active federal service, the effective date of this retirement to be 30 September 1959. Following is a resumé of assignments performed by this officer during the period 1942 - 1959:

2. It will be noted that a major portion of this individual's career has been devoted to intelligence community activities. His most recent assignment, that of Senior Instructor for SR/DOB, has produced a typical exemplary performance by this individual. Loss of the services of this unique employee would work as a detriment to the SR/DOB training program, his performance having been rated either superior or outstanding in all categories.

3. In consideration of the above, it is requested that action be approved providing for the employment of this individual effective 1 October 1959 under Project AEACRE, Allotment #0134-0000-5258, at a per annum salary of \$6,000. Contracting of this individual under a typical contract employee type agreement will not constitute the basis of a request for an increase in funds over those which have already been allotted.
