I. Identification and Description of Target Area. (Ref para 4-e (1)).

Project AE-ACRE provides for an agent training base in the United States in support of operations designed to penetrate any area included within the boundary limits of the U.S.S.R. Exact targets are determined and assigned on an individual basis by U.S.S.R. Division area branches.

II. Gperational Objectives, Summary. (Ref para 4-a (2)).

The operational objective is the recruitment and training of agents for dispatch into the U.S.S.R. on missions as established by the SR Division and its branches. It is proposed that these operations and projects will be continued and expanded as the requirements increase. To facilitate the

Frogress has been made to procure an area large enough to carry on considerable of the training in one area as well as housing for offices of DOB and billeting for both indigenous and staff personnel.
