MEMORANDUM FOR : Chief, OR PI

SUBJECT : Agenda for conferences with Representatives of CSGB

1. It is suggested that the following points be discussed in conferences with representatives of CSGB.

a. Special Procedure Entry problems

1. Utilization of air transportation set up by Air-Maritime Division.

2. Documentation necessary.

3. Better use of cables. At the present time, a great deal of unnecessary work is caused by cables that are not clearly understood.

b. Staff personnel who will be transferred from CSGB to DOB.

1. Case officers are urgently needed. (DOB has approximately 15 case officer slots open from GS-7 to GS-11.)

2. Safe-housekeepers can be utilized. DOB is anxious to procure couples who are reliable, can cook and clean, and who speak the language.

3. A good photography instructor is needed. Technical services specialists (secret-writing, flags and seals, caskets, etc.) are also required.

c. Indigenous Personnel who will be transferred from CSGB to DOB.

1. The greatest need is for recent high caliber defectors from the Soviet Union who can be used as instructors.

1. It is requested that CSOB ship by air a copy of all training materials that have been produced in the field. It is to be noted that this material is currently being sent to IB. The time it takes for IB to reproduce and disseminate the material could be reduced if CSOB would send a few extra copies along for DOB.
