

Subject: Projected Schedule for Phasing into Domestic Training Activity

1. General principles to be observed:

- a. No field station will take on any new training commitments of types which would normally fall to the domestic facility.
- b. Personnel presently located at headquarters would be retained for assignment to domestic training if considered suitable.
- c. Certain qualified personnel now in the field would be transferred to headquarters for duty with the domestic training facility even though their normal two year tour may not yet have ended.

As planned

2. Specific schedules by projects:

a. Lithuanian

Present 4-man team to be dispatched by spring 1952. Case officers [] return immediately after this dispatch (April-May 1952).

DTA: 3 Lith. contract instructors on hand
1 Lith. contract instructor now receiving specialized documents course to be completed by mid-December 1951.

Two of the above four will take W/T training with agents and will become W/T instructors themselves by June 1952.

Agents: 4 U.S. recruited agents are expected to begin training by 1 Jan. 1952.

Case Officers on hand for above training unit are:

- [] - tradecraft
- [] - Ops Assistant
- 4 native instructors - tradecraft

Training area: One 200 acre farm and suitable house now on hand.

b. Latvian

Current situation: To date no training of any Latvians anywhere.

[At present 1 uncleared and 1 cleared agent in U.S.] In Germany 2 cleared W/T agents, 2 cleared indigenous instructors, 4 uncleared agent prospects, 2 cleared recruiters, spotters and possible instructors, one of whom is [the principal agent. In Sweden one spotter.

DTA: 1 Lat. contract agent is on hand who is at present compiling ops info for use in training the 2 agents recruited in the U.S. This contract agent will also participate in all phases of training.

2 prospective Latvian agents have been furnished, of whom 1 has not been contacted as yet and the other must be psychologically assessed.

~~Propose that the 2 cleared agents and 2 native instructors in Germany be brought to the U.S. and incorporated into the domestic training project.~~

Case Officers: Case Officers [] and 2 native instructors should be brought back from Germany by ~~June~~ June 1952. Training unit will then consist of: []

c. Estonian

Current situation: 6 agents cleared and awaiting assessment in Sweden. 1 native trainer, spotter, recruiter, and PA cleared in Germany. 1 native trainer and recruiter under consideration at present on the high seas; will be interviewed possibly in Copenhagen.
