MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: IUDEPOT

1. The following points were made at a meeting 3 May 1965 attended by C/GB, DC/GB, []

a. OTR's willingness and ability to accept all training requirements still to be determined. This problem will be resolved between OTR and SOD.

b. NE should take over complete responsibility for ARLEAP assets (since they are not available for general cold-war use) with OTR doing any training. A meeting is projected soon among representatives of NE, OTR, SOD, and SOD/IUDEPOT to resolve this problem.

c. IUDEPOT will be considered one activity--there will be no separate "base" as such.

d. There will be no further routine recruiting by IUDEPOT.

e. Actions indicated with respect to current pool of assets are: (1) elimination of deadwood, (2) determination of what is needed (e.g., added training) to prepare remainder of assets for maximum cold-war utility, (3) determination of optimum number of "hard-core" assets which should be retained. [] stated that an extensive review of all assets had been made and that a working paper should be ready later in the day (3 May).

2. [] was asked to submit a draft renewal of IUDEPOT to C/GB by 17 May 1965. During discussion it was agreed that this would also serve as a status report to the A/DDP, and savings in funds and personnel already made and to be made would be emphasized. The draft renewal should contain also justification for the retention of the military personnel.

3. [] stated that new premises are still awaiting determination by GSA that the construction of Tempo E would accept the added weight of a secure area and necessary

safes. [] stated that much classified material is being retired. but that a considerable amount should be retained. [] will determine whether training material, which is classified but not identified as Agency material, can be stored at Fort Meade.

4. [] recommended that the equipment in the photo lab at the Alexandria office be retained and stored at Fort Meade. C/GB agreed that this be done for the time being.
