**SUBJECT:** WUDEPOT

**REFERENCE:** A. ADD/P Memo of 24 March 1965, Subject,  
"Project WUDEPOT, Reorientation and  
Transfer of Jurisdiction"  
B. C/DO Memo of 12 March to ADD/P,  
Subject, "Considerations of the  
Contingency Problem"

1. Reference A transferred jurisdiction of WUDEPOT to SOD and directed a reduction of personnel and facilities to "Condition II" of reference B.

2. It is requested that SOD/SS take the following actions:

- a. Reassign personnel per attachment A.
- b. Reduce WUDEPOT (DOB) classified material now at Alexandria DOB offices to minimum. Target is about ten safes.
- c. Transfer or turn in unneeded equipment (now at Alexandria DOB office).
- d. Transfer vehicles per attachment B.
- e. Find new office space for ten staff personnel. See attachment C for current status.

3. The target date for move to new offices is 1 June 1965. Most of the personnel actions and all of the reduction of files and equipment should take place before that date.

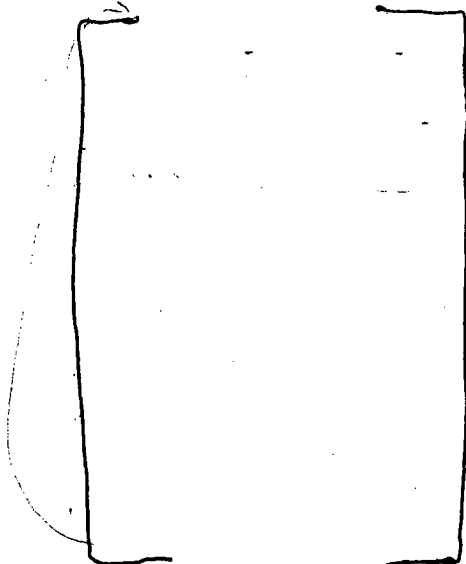
