1. A discussion was held on 9 October 1964 in the office of GB/SOD. Present were:



- 2. The purpose of the meeting was to advise WH and AF Division representatives of Mr. Karamessines' thoughts on anticipated Agency contingency agent needs for cold war situations.
- 3. presented a brief background of DOB and the WUDEPOT hot-war project, the agents' response to the Cuba and Berlin crises, and the present review of agents being conducted to identify all-purpose types. He then outlined Mr. Karamessines' ideas of additional pools of trained agents possessing knowledge of French, Spanish and Portuguese languages for possible unilateral use by CIA in cold-war situations in Africa or WH Division areas of interest.
- 4. were informed of the preliminary work presently being done at DOB to identify and obtain clearances on additional agent candidates as might serve in their areas, and were asked to provide such specific agent requirements, standards and guidance as they could to assist in the selection of appropriate candidates.
