A. Memorandum from the DCI for Chairman, Joint Chiefs of Staff, Subject: The Criteria for Determination of Wartime Military Requirements for CIA Clandestine Operations, Dated 29 Oct 1955

1. Reference A was prepared by this Agency to clairly the CIA concept of its
IIW role in support of wartime military operations including a statement as to the
standards of kind and degree of action which should bracket the definition of requirements upon the CIA.

- 2. In consideration of Reference A the JCS by Reference B replied to CIA that the degree of action by the CIA which best meets military requirements is the development of U.S. unilateral action nuclei, located within the area of potential operations, comparimented in accordance with the respective purposes to be served and equipped with communications and supporting facilities. (This reiterated the CIA position noted in Reference A). The JCS noted that they were aware that in some instances a lesser type or multilateral asset might be all that could be developed in passes in a
