SUBJECT : Availability of U/W Assets

1. Confirming our conversation of today, will you please look over the attached papers and give me the benefit of your thoughts on the sort of answer we should give to WPS with respect to the six requirements of interest to SR. Since WPS will in turn have to prepare a reply for headquarters to go back to SWPE by 15 January, WPS has asked that SR, EE, and WE provide required answers not later than Monday, 11 January.

2. Obviously, the question raised in sub-para a., of the 4 January memo does not apply to SR since all our assets used as a basis for acceptance of the U/W requirements are "held in the US". We will have to arrive at a figure representing the number of days after D-Day before the AEDEPOT assets used for the acceptance of BA-6, SR-3, SR-5, SR-6, SR-9, and SR-26 could be expected to be ready to leave our proposed Redeployment Site staging area for the European Theater. Secondly, we will have to indicate the "number of persons comprising the individual assets". (According to my records two agents - AEDEPOT/4 and 5, were used as the basis for the acceptance of requirement SR-3; in all other cases only a single asset was involved per requirement.) As for "compartmentation requirements" I doubt if we will have to worry about segregating our agents from each other for reasons which we have discussed.

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3. With specific reference to requirement SR-6, my record shows that this is the only one that was accepted on the basis of an agent that had not been trained as of the time of the U/W requirements exercise and on which the acceptance was based on an agent expected to be trained "during FY 1960". Now that more classes have been processed I assume that you can assign a specific agent to SR-6.

4. I discussed this problem with WPS in a meeting this morning and made the point that, while I appreciate that the military wants to know when we would have our externally-held assets ready for airlifting, it will be necessary to make the point to the military that any indication of readiness is a very rough approximation and is dependent upon a number of factors that cannot be predicted at the moment (e.g., how much advance notice, if any, we will get before D-Day, whether or not there will be any way for the agent to get from his hometown to the Relocation Site, destruction or denial of roads because of atomic strikes, etc.). [] of WPS indicated that the reply from headquarters to SWPE will cover us on this point. I believe that, subject to some statement indicating the degree of difficulty involved in making this sort of forecast, we can indicate (in order to satisfy this requirement) that we could have our agents ready to leave Washington for the Theater approximately 10/15 days after D-Day.

SUBJECT: Availability of Certain Assets

1. USCGINCEUR is currently engaged in scheduling employment of transport aircraft available in the theater during the period D-day to D plus 30. In order that Air aircraft requirements for early deployment of Army Special Forces teams may be determined, certain information not available to SWFE is needed.

2. Since the Special Forces teams with a D-day to D plus 30 commitment will be employed in conjunction with XBIAR assets and the assets programmed for certain US areas are being held in CONUS, the dates on which the needed assets are to be available fully prepared for employment in the theater are prerequisites to air support planning. Accordingly, it is requested that SWFE be furnished with the dates after D-day on which the USFE requirements for each of the below listed US areas will be available in the theater.

3. These US areas and the priorities assigned to them are in some cases at variance with Annex 1, USCGINCEUR OPLAN 100-2, but this reflects changes which have developed as a result of a reevaluation by SWFE of the US areas. The category classification will be eliminated and all areas will be assigned Priority I or Priority II. Such changes and others will be reflected in Annex 1, now under revision, and in the revision of SWFE OPLAN 1-57. All of the areas listed below are now Priority I areas, ten of them have not previously been designated as Special Forces areas by USCGINCEUR.

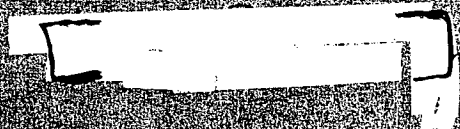

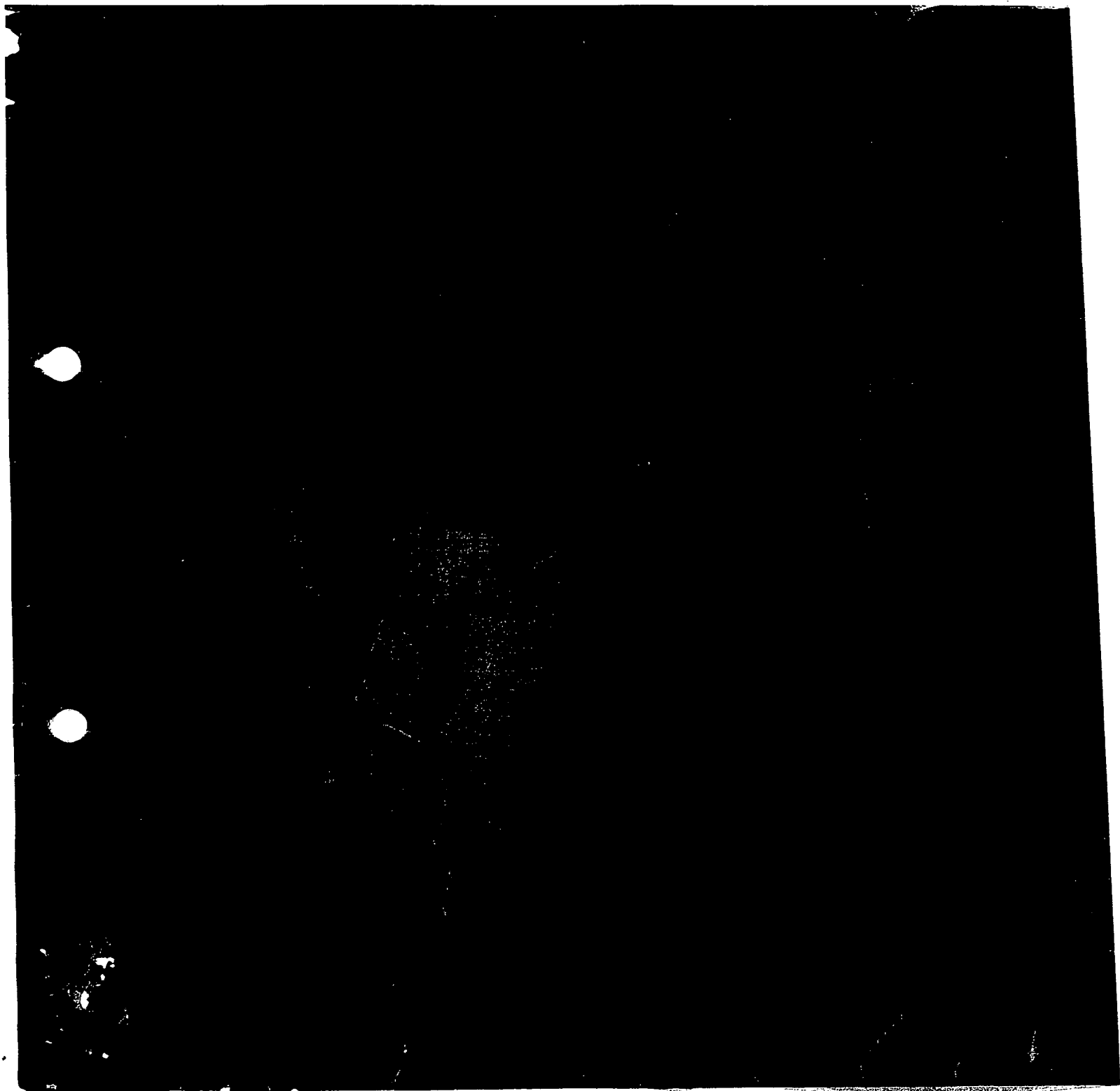

However, this request may also be connected with the JCS position regarding KUBARK acceptances contained in the attachment to Reference a.

7. Reply is requested not later than 15 January 1960 so that SWPE may further the close relationship with HQUSEUCOM emphasized by Headquarters KUBARK in question x of the attachment to Reference b.

SUBJECT : Unconventional Warfare Capabilities Report

REFERENCES : a. CIA memo to JCS, dtd 16 Jan. 57, "Status of CIA Capability to Meet Unconventional Warfare Requirements."
b. Chief, PP Staff memo to Chief, SR Division dtd 18 Sept. 58, "Revised Unconventional Warfare Requirements."
c. SR/COP/PLANS memo to Chief, Domestic Operations Base, dtd 16 Oct. 58, "Revised U/W Requirements for CINCEUR, CINJAL, and CINCPAC - (USSR Areas)."

1. In accordance with your suggestion in para. 6 of reference c. above, [] of this office has utilized the information and materials you have provided and has set forth our capabilities on Forms 973, which are attached herewith.

2. You will note that we have accepted all requirements for our areas. We feel we could not justifiably do otherwise, since the ARDEPOT Program is well under way and is specifically intended for the purpose of developing "hot war" U W assets.

3. The category definition attachments to the memo to G/PP, subject "Revised U W Requirements," are, in general, nebulous or vague and in some respects contradictory. The following recommended action seems appropriate to us at this time:

a. Request JCS to require from the various commanders-in-chief a uniform method of stating their requirements, e.g.:

- (1) CATEGORIES - Designation of targets according to the primary functions of each or the U W tasks to be performed at each one.
- (2) PRIORITIES - A further designation according to the time element.

4. In summary, we feel that we definitely have the current capability to fulfill some of the imposed requirements and that we are potentially capable of fulfilling the others with the continued progress of the ARDEPOT Program.
