Project AEDEPOT

1. Since the initial class which began in February 1957, DOB has trained a total of 128 students. This figure includes 19 students who comprise the present class which is due to graduate on 11 May 1963.

2. Of this 128 total, 14 (or about 11%) have been dropped for one reason or other. This does not represent a complete loss however, since their 201 files have been circulated through other branches and divisions for their possible use as legal travelers, etcetera.

3. Of the 95 student graduates, one has performed two missions, one for SR and one for EE. A second student has performed a mission for NE. A total of 21 other students have supported WH in a variety of roles during the past two years. In addition, 18 volunteered for an EE assignment, were recalled, trained and provided a standby EE reserve during 1962.
