SUBJECT : Projected 1964 Training, SR/DOB

1. Following is a general break-down of the training to be conducted by the Training Staff, SR/DOB, during fiscal 1964. More detailed information will be furnished at your request.

2. Training Programs:

a. SWIFT STRIKE III

SWIFT STRIKE III is an Army-Air Forces War Game in which SR/DOB assets will be employed during the development of the unconventional warfare phase.

1. Sixteen to Eighteen AEDFOT assets will be called-up for the exercise.
2. Assets will receive refresher training at Fort Meade 1 - 7 July.
3. Assets will be in the field 7 - 19 July.
4. Assets will be debriefed, paid, etc., during the period 19 - 22 July at Fort Meade.

b. SEA RULER

SEA RULER is an European version of SWIFT STRIKE III. AEDFOT and OKWHEPPER assets will be employed in the development of the unconventional warfare phase.

1. Twenty to twenty-four AEDFOT assets and eight OKWHEPPER assets will be called-up for this exercise.
2. Assets will receive refresher training in preparation for the field exercise at Fort Meade 18 - 25 August.
3. Assets will be dispatched to Europe 25 August and will actually be in the field 13 - 14 days.
4. Assets will depart Frankfurt for Fort Meade approximately 10 September.

5. Assets will turn in equipment, be debriefed, paid, etc., 11 - 13 September.

c. **AEDEPOT Class No. 13**

AEDEPOT Class No. 13 is the regular sixteen week basic course of the AEDEPOT Program. The basic course includes SR, EE and NE assets.

1. It is anticipated that Class 13 will be made up of twenty trainees (9 SR, 9 EE and 2 NE).

2. The class will be in session from 25 August to 14 December. There will be trips as follows:

Camp Pickett - Basic Field Training - 27 August - 13 September.

ISOTROPIC - Demolitions and Sabotage - 1 - 10 October.

Fort Bragg - Parachute Training - Commo Air field exercise
29 October - 7 November.

Camp Pickett - Comprehensive Exercise - 3 - 12 December.

d. **Basic Parachute Training and Refresher Program**

This course will be a part of the regular call-up and retraining program for calendar 1963. The assets will be refreshed in communication and field activities and in addition will be taught parachute jumping.

1. It is anticipated that the class will consist of 20 to 30 SR, EE and NE assets who have not completed the basic jump program or taken part in other 1963 call-up training (A and B above).

2. The program will last three weeks. The approximate dates are 13 October to 3 November.

e. **AEDEPOT Class No. 14**

AEDEPOT Class No. 14 will begin a series of basic courses which will run for a minimum of 18 weeks. Current studies indicate the need for additional time and it is probably that the basic course will be extended to 20 weeks in Class No. 15 if not earlier.

1. The size and composition of Class No. 14 should be approximately the same as Class No. 13.

2. The class will be in session for 18 weeks, 19 January 1964 - 23 May 1964. The trips to training sites out of the Washington area will be much the same as are

indicated for Class 13. Dates will be established after the basic program has been sketched out.

f. Summer Refresher Training (June 1964)

At this time we can only predict that the Training Staff will be involved with the training of one or two 2-week call-up groups. This activity has not been scheduled at this time.

3. The dates and numbers of students cited above are only estimates at this time. The dates will be resolved as the use of training areas is agreed upon. The numbers of trainees involved in any one activity depend upon a number of variables.
