## CI Staff Comments - Project AEDEPOT

CI Staff recommends approval of renewal request for Project AEDEPOT. Project personnel have stated that each agent is asked about correspondence with Soviet bloc residents and about identities of other agents known and that this information is recorded. C/DOB has said that no security losses or exposure of AEDEPOT agents occurred during utilization for the JMATE operation. In the case of NE agents the agent file is transferred to NE upon completion of training, but DOB keeps a card on each such agent, because of yearly training by DOB, giving the agent's identity, address, nationality and other data. DOB keeps the agent file on EE agents. Only staff personnel have access to these files. CI Staff recommends that the number of such personnel be kept to a minimum. Cyril ROSONY (p), a contract employee type "B" knows identities of all the agents and debriefs them for biographical information from birth. This information is obtained as a DOB debriefer, under CSA granted in April 1959, when only SR Agents were involved. For greater operational security it is recommended that someone else debrief the EE and NE agents, to avoid overconcentration of knowledge of "hot-war" agents. ROSONY satisfactorily passed LCFLUTTER examination in June 1957. Nevertheless he is Russian born, married to a Russian born wife, who corresponds regularly with relatives in Belgrade, Yugoslavia. Apart from the Soviet interest that both might have aroused while post-war employees at the Army Language School at Monterey, ROSONY was in contact with German Military intelligence (Abwehr) in Bulgaria during World War II; was active in Russian emigre groups; and worked for UNRRA and IRO in Germany. In 1957 ROSONY stated that an MVD major had asked about him in Yugoslavia in 1947 or 1948 and that the Soviets in 1956 asked his wife's cousin, a Belgrade resident, about him.
