: Request Renewal Project AEMANNER

- 1. Project AEMARKER is a project in the REDSKIN program. It was originally approved in April 1955. Its purpose is to procure intelligence of the USSR via Lithuanian channels. AEMARKER's efforts are directed principally to the pursuit, cultivation and exploitation of mail channels, contacts with selected emigres and legal travelers to and from the USSR, particularly Lithuania. It has succeeded in establishing sources for subsequent exploitation and in producing operational information.
- 2. Project AEMANNER has developed mail channels, and established a relationship with German maritime businessmen whose ships visit Soviet ports, and seamen visiting the USSR. The project also served as an instrument to spot three potential candidates for a REDSKIN or REDSCK mission.
- 3. The REDSKIN activity undertaken under Project ARMANNER is furthering the Clandestine Services General Plan USSR Operational Program for FY 1958.
- 4. Summary of AEMANNER accomplishments in the period August 1956 August 1957 and planned future activities:

## a. Accomplishments:

- (1) Established contacts among emigre groups who keep us informed on matters of REDEKIN interest, such as mail channels, possible repatriates to the homeland, and legal travelers.
- (2) Spotted three individuals who are presently being assessed for a REDSKIN or REDSOX mission.
- (3) Debriefed 

  , a recent Soviet defector, who provided valuable information, especially for the planning of REDSOX Project AEAMBER.

- (4) Established two mail channels into Lithuania.
- (5) Spotted an additional mail channel into Lithuania.
- (6) Recruited one individual for a possible tourist trip into Lithuania.
- (7) Spotted another individual for a possible tourist trip into Lithuania.
- (8) Spotted one individual who may be used as a principal agent to (a) interrogate people who have repatriated to Germany from the USSR, (b) investigate and develop leads involving people repatriating from the West to the USSR, and (c) develop cases involving West German tourists traveling to the USSR.
- b. Correspondence from the field suggests strong and continuing interests in the development of this project.
- c. Planned future activities:
  - (1) To continue spotting, recruiting, briefing, debriefing, and developing REDSKIN agents.
  - (2) To continue spetting for prospective REDSOX agent candidates, when required.
  - (3) To:continue spotting and developing leads to mail channels into the USSR.
  - (4) To continue spotting, developing, and recruiting merchant seamen who visit Soviet ports.
  - (5) To continue developing operational information for Lithuanian FI and PP operations.
- d. In the period 1 August 1957 31 July 1958, Project AEMANNER's efforts will be directed toward production of positive intelligence, as well as operational information for Lithuanian FI and PP operation.
- e. The efforts of the contract agent personnel will also be re-directed toward emphasis on positive intelligence production.

## f. Finances:

- (1) A total of \$37,701 was disbursed on Project ARMANNER between 1 August 1956 and 31 July 1957.
