1. Your attention is invited to the fact that FOB is still charging AECORSAIR expenses to AEMANNER, in accordance with Reference B. This has resulted in obligations incurred as of 31 December 1958 of \$13,670.00 as against \$8,706.00 approved for AEMANNER for field operations through 31 January 1959.

2. Since we will be unable to charge AECORSAIR and []'s expenses, such as housing, car maintenance, travel, etc., to AEMANNER project after 31 January 1959, please advise where these expenses should be charged. Incidentally, since [] performs specific tasks for AECOMPASS and CAVENUE operations, we will continue to charge the operational expenses directly attributable to these activities to project AECOMPASS and CALL/OOA, respectively. In connection with AECORSAIR expenses, there will be no problem if AECORSAIR project is approved before 1 February 1959.

3. Your advice would also be appreciated as to the new status of the requirement of a new Field Project Outline for AEMANNER 6, as stated in paragraph 1 of Reference A.
