MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, FI

SUBJECT : Request for Amendment of Project AEMARSH

1. It is requested that subject Project be amended to include the employment of the following person:

[] (POC NO. #-33942), a Latvian DP in Germany, who has been a part-time contract employee until now. He has a Ph.D. in archeology from the University of Munich and is also an expert cartographer. During World War II, he served in the Latvian Legion and later participated in clandestine intelligence activities against the USSR. He has been associated with this Agency since 1948 in a number of capacities, mainly for the purpose of reproducing and coloring maps and as a letter-drop in Germany for receiving and mailing operational S/W letters to and from the USSR. In addition, he is to be utilized as a principal agent to spot and develop REDSKIN leads, and to spot and recruit REDSOX agent prospects. He is also to carry on []'s former activities in Germany: locating and debriefing Latvian refugees. [] is now in the United States and working for this Agency under the AEMARSH Project.

2. It is further requested that subject amendment provide for a salary of \$1,300.00 annually for [] . This amount is to be paid in the form of DM by the field station. This amendment requires an additional authorization of \$217 since the project is due for renewal on 1 March 1955.
