The following information is being forwarded for your consideration in preparation of Project ARMARSH renewal request which should be submitted in accordance with FR 230-620. In order to have the project renewal approved before the expiration of the current Project ARMARSH, it is requested, if at all possible, that the Project ARMARSH renewal be submitted prior to 1 February 1958.

1. We would like to point out that Project ARMARSH renewal should not be based on all the operations against the target country **IMPERY 1** as it has been the case until now. It is a fact that the current Project ARMARSH has become too cumbersome and over-worked to be managed effectively. Therefore, the present need is to develop a more efficient way of managing this Project. This can be accomplished by writing the Project ARMARSH renewal in such a way as reflect the P/A's, in this case **ARMARSH/1's** functions and activities only rather than including all the agents and operations against the country.
2. Since the P/A of Project ARMARSH, **ARMARSH/1**, is involved in a variety of operational tasks for the Frankfurt Operations Base and most of his present tasks are identical or similar to the tasks assigned to **ARMARSH/1** under Project ARMARSH as forwarded to you in **REFW-7904** dated 8 November 1958, it is logical that you may wish to follow the general outline of the current Project ARMARSH for the preparation of Project ARMARSH renewal.
3. Agents and activities developed by **ARMARSH/1** should be put under the relevant project, such as , or handled as developmental until the agent or activity warrants submitting a field project outline. For example, **ARMARSH/15** activity can be supported through OOA funds until regular utilization justifies requesting project approval. Of course, no salary can be paid under OOA. will become the subject of a separate project. can be a temporary exception, and should be included in your request for renewal of ARMARSH. The reason for this latter is that there is no other project at present to cover him. We prefer that you transfer support facilities such as accommodation addresses, safehouses, quad-personal vehicles, and others to already existing support projects, not necessarily connected with Baltic projects, when this is possible. Please let us know how you plan to accomplish these transfers so that this information may be transmitted with the request for renewal of ARMARSH.
