1. REGRET MISUNDERSTANDING CAUSED BY FAILURE ADEQUATELY REPORT OBJECTIVES CACHINO ONE AND EIGHT CAMPOSANTO ONE MISSIONS.

2. ALL AGENT MISSIONS PLANNED IN GENERAL OUTLINE BY CASE OFFICER AND MAT INSTRUCTOR WITH THREE PRIMARY OBJECTIVES GIVEN EQUAL PRIORITY (A) CONTACT INDIGENOUS RESISTANCE (B) CONTACT SAFE SUPPORT POINTS (C) COVERAGE SPECIFIC PRIORITY INTELLIGENCE TARGETS.

3. AGENT THEN ASSESSED AS TO CAPABILITIES AND BACKGROUND WITH SPECIFIC REFERENCE FOLLOWING POINTS:

A. WHAT GEOGRAPHICAL AREA IS AGENT FAMILIAR WITH AND COULD SUPPORT COVER STORY FOR?

B. HAS AGENT FRIENDS OR RELATIVES TO DEVELOP AS SUPPORT POINTS?

C. HAS AGENT INTELLIGENCE ABILITY SUFFICIENT ENABLE HIM LOCATE INDIGENOUS RESISTANCE IF EXTANT AND TO SECURITY CONTACT SAME?

4. CACHINO ONE AND EIGHT BOTH LOW LEVEL AGENTS OF VERY

IT IS FORBIDDEN TO MAKE A COPY OF THIS MESSAGE

LIMITED INTELLIGENCE WHO COULD NOT QUALIFY UNDER 2C ABOVE AND WHO CLAIM TO HAVE NEITHER FRIENDS NOR RELATIVES TO CONTACT UNDER 2B ABOVE. THESE AGENTS WERE ALSO VERY LIMITED GEOGRAPHICALLY UNDER 2A ABOVE BECAUSE THEY WERE ONLY FAMILIAR WITH THEIR HOME LOCALITY.

5. FACED WITH THESE SEVERE LIMITATIONS IT WAS FELT WORTHWHILE TO DISPATCH THESE AGENTS FOR TWO PURPOSES:

1. TO COLLECT OPERATIONAL DATA IE INFO ON CURRENT DOCUMENTATION, MOVEMENT AND RESISTANCE LAWS AND REGULATIONS, AND ALL OTHER INFO NECESSARY TO ALLOW TWO TO SURVIVE AND OPERATE IN THE TARGET AREA: 2. TO HAVE THEM PERFORM OBSERVER TYPE MISSIONS ON HIGHEST PRIORITY TARGETS: IE CACHINO EIGHT TO COVER TWO AIRFIELDS BELIEVED TO HOUSE ATOMIC BOMB CARRIERS, CACHINO ONE TO COVER ATOMIC BOMB INSTALLATION. BOTH MISSIONS REQUIRE ONLY LOW LEVEL OBSERVATION AND REPORTING. IN BOTH CASES THESE TARGETS WERE WITHIN THE GEOGRAPHICAL AREA WITH WHICH THESE AGENTS WERE FAMILIAR.

6. THE COLLECTION OF OPERATIONAL DATA PER PARA FIVE ABOVE IS BASIC TO ALL TYPE MISSIONS IN TARGET AREA AND WE REGARD ITS COLLECTION AS OUR PRIMARY JOB FOR AT LEAST THIS SUMMER REGARDLESS OF FUTURE OBJECTIVES. OUR SUPPORT FACILITIES AIR DISPATCH DOCUMENTATION BRIEFING MATERIAL ARE STILL AS RUDIMENTARY AS TO PRECLUDE ANY REAL CONCENTRATION ON MORE SPECIFIC MISSIONS OF WHATEVER TYPE AT THIS TIME. ONLY BY GREATEST EFFORT HERE FULLEST SUPPORT AT HOME CAN WE IMPROVE THESE FACILITIES TO POINT WHERE 1952 MISSIONS CAN BECOME MORE SPECIALIZED PER SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES.

7. COMPOSANTO ONE FAR MORE INTELLIGENT TYPE, HAS ADDRESSES, CONVINCED HE CAN CONTACT RESISTANCE ELEMENTS IN HIS NATIVE AREA. THEREFORE HIS MISSION IS PRECISELY THE TWO POINTS OUTLINED PARA FOUR REF. AS BEING ZACACTUS PRIME OBJECTIVES.

8. FACT REFERENCE CABLE SENT G CHANNEL ONLY EGRESS NOT IN ACCORD WITH [] UNDERSTANDING THAT [] AS CHIEF AND [] AS DEPUTY CSOB HAD EQUAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ZACACTIN AND ZACACTUS MATTERS AND THAT IF WASHG FELT THAT ZACACTUS MATTERS WERE BEING NEGLECTED BOTH [] AND [] HAD RESPONSIBILITY. EXPLAIN THIS NEGLECT AND VICE VERSA. IF THIS MISUNDERSTANDING [] PART WOULD APPRECIATE YOUR GUIDANCE. HOWEVER FEEL MOST STRONGLY THAT ANYTHING LESS THAN COMPLETELY CANDID TREATMENT OF THESE INTRAMURAL DIFFERENCES AMONG ALL CONCERNED WILL TOTALLY DESTROY ANY ATTEMPT OPERATE COMBINED BASE. AND EQUALLY CONVINCED THAT PRESENT COMBINATION ADEQUATELY REPRESENTS BOTH INTERESTS AS [] UNDERSTANDS THEM ON BASIS OUR PRESENT KNOWLEDGE OF TARGET AREA AND PRESENT MATURETY OF OUR OPERATIONS.
