1. In the event the CAWNPORE 1 couriers succeed in exfiltrating to the West, it will be desirable to know the identity of the person or persons who briefed and dispatched them. It is assumed that SUBJECT will have participated in the send-off. However, in view of GARTHAGE 3's report of his reception with CAWNPORE 1 leaders in which he states that although he was instructed to contact the Provid leader, he was received by at least four members any of which could have been the top man but none of which could he positively identify as being such, it is conceivable that these couriers found themselves in a similar situation and consequently do not know whether SUBJECT participate in their dispatch. On the other hand, the couriers might know SUBJECT. In any case, we should be in a position either to confirm SUBJECT'S identity if the couriers admit knowledgeability of him, or to establish his identity from the couriers' description in the event SUBJECT participated in the briefing and dispatch without their knowing who he actually was.

2. For the above considerations, aside from the normal requirements inherent in seeking information on SUBJECT, it is necessary that we accumulate all available information on SUBJECT from whatever sources. To-date, headquarters files on SUBJECT contain only scanty information, provided by CASSOWARY 2, who, when presenting this information, was not certain that the person he was describing was actually the SUBJECT.

3. Other than CASSOWARY 2, no other sources for data on SUBJECT were tapped, although several exist. These are CASSOWARLES 3 and 6. As the undersigned remembers, CASSOWARY 3 mentioned several times that he thinks he knows SUBJECT although never positive in this identification. On the

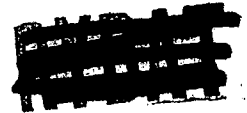

other hand, CASSOWARY 6, when informed of the request from CANNPORE in the fall of 1952 for our aid in SUBJECT'S proposed exfiltration, and later when informed of the decoration he received from the homeland, stated to the undersigned that he definitely knows SUBJECT personally. In fact, it was CASSOWARY 6 who originally provided us with the knowledge of SUBJECT'S bad kidney condition. (It is regretted that more information regarding SUBJECT was not elicited from CASSOWARY 6 at this opportune time.)

4. In view of CASSOWARY 6's professed knowledge of SUBJECT, it is suggested that he be questioned discreetly on this knowledge whenever the opportunity to do so presents itself. In this respect, CASSOWARY 3 should also be milked for what he knows of SUBJECT.



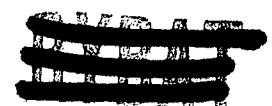
