- 2. The Bulletin has 25 pages and carries three articles. Page one officially asknowledges receipt by the UHVR of \$7,31h given it by the Ukrainian Congress Committee of America. Pages 2-21 comprise an interesting article by the late Major POLTAVA on the subject, "Preparation for a Third World War and the Tasks of the Ukrainian Nation". Pages 22-25 carry an appeal to Ukrainians in the Soviet Army on how to act should a Third World War begin.
- 3. AECASSOWARY 3 has learned from AECAVATINA 5 that the same pouch contained another UHVR Bulletin, date unknown, and as yet unavailable to AECASSOWARY.1.
