Political Correspondence with the Field - Transmittal
for AECASS/2

The letter quoted below was received from SMYOPIA on this date. The attachment (letter to AECASS/2) is being forwarded to Headquarters under separate cover for handling.

"At the (KUBARK/SMYOPIA) Conference of February 1954 about (AECASSOWARY/1) and (AECAVATINA/6), we agreed to let you know the contents of any political correspondence with our group in the field. Soon after this conference, we gave the field a summary of the events leading up to the establishment of the TRIUMVIRATE on orders from the Homeland, and told them of (AECAVATINA/1's) last minute decision not to join this TRIUMVIRATE.

"In answer to this MIRON replied that he regretted that a further break had occurred, but that he could not commit himself on the issues until he had been able to study the cases of both sides in the dispute. He asked that LEMISH should be informed as soon as possible of this new development.

"Our reply to this stressed that the LVOV KRAJ was not called upon to give judgement on the rights and wrongs of the dispute, that this function was the prerogative of the Leadership of all (AECAWNPORE/2) whose decision the LVOV KRAJ must accept, and that (AECAVATINA/1) could refer his disagreement with the orders from the Ukraine to LEMISH only and not to subordinate KRAJS.

"In accordance with the procedure agreed at the (KUBARK/SMYOPIA) Conference, (AECAVATINA/5) has written to (AECASS/2) about this political correspondence. His letter to (AECASS/2) is attached and we would be grateful if you would arrange for it to be passed to him."
