1. Contact Operations

A. Translations of the reports prepared by Stephen Oliyuk on his trip to the USSR have not yet been completed but the translated portion covering conversations with six individuals in the USSR and one in Poland have been forwarded to SR/Reports for dissemination and to SR/3-FI. The reports cover his conversations with following:

(1) Iu TSIBA, Kiev, Chief of the protocol and consular affairs branch of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs USSR.

(2) Olesia DORICHENKO, Kiev, dancer with the Verlovka chorus

(3) Mykola HRYTSYUKA, Kiev, member of the Literary Institute, Ukrainian Academy of Sciences.

(4) Evheny SHCHERBA, Stanislaw, (present occupation not known) former Ukrainian underground member and a Soviet pilot, veteran of the Korean War.

(5) A radio technician in Lvov

(6) A shoemaker in Lvov

(7) Mykola SIVITSKY, Warsaw, works in editorial offices of NASHE SLOVO (Our Word), Educational branch.

B. [] met with Oliyuk on two occasions and plans to debrief him further regarding his last trip and tentative plans for another trip in the near future.

C. Reports on the ABCASSOWARY contact activities at the International Trade Fair in Marseilles were received but have not yet been translated. A report of the contacts and conversations will be made in the November activities report.
