<p>1. It has been reported to ABCASSOWARY/1 (IDEN A under separate cover) that many, if not most, of the Soviets assigned to the Bhillai steel project are from the Ukraine and that they are conspicuously identifiable as Ukrainians as distinct from Great Russians. It is rare that Soviet Ukrainians appear in such a large group outside the Soviet Union; thus those at Bhillai present a worthwhile target for contact operations if they are accessible.</p> <p>2. The true identity of ABCASSOWARY/1 will explain the special relationship of that organization to the Ukrainians in Bhillai. KUBARK interest is based on what seems to be a propensity on the part of Ukrainian nationalists for anti-regime activity. The ABCASSOWARY/1 organization has demonstrated its ability in other countries in the contact field. These operations, when properly conducted, are unobtrusive and generally do not produce flaps. Their objective is to get close to vulnerable targets for purposes of elicitation and ultimately recruitment. While anti-Soviet literature is sometimes used, it is passed discreetly and for the specific purpose of softening up the target.</p> <p>3. From this distance and with a minimum of information, it is difficult to gauge the practicality of any scheme for contact operations by ABCASSOWARY/1. The remoteness of Bhillai is appreciated, and at this time the group has no representative in India. However, it does have a possible candidate to send there in the person of IDEN B. IDEN B has the necessary academic background to take on a teaching assignment, and it has been suggested at Headquarters that [] might be called upon to make an arrangement for him in Nagpur, which, according to our information, is where Soviets on leave from Bhillai often lay over while waiting for further transportation. Nagpur seems to be the closest city of any size to Bhillai and might therefore be a practical base for operations.</p> <p>4. The addressees are asked to forward comments on the feasibility of the operational suggestions contained herein and any suggestions as to other alternatives.</p>
