Headquarters wishes to thank for the information contained in the reference. **ARCASSOWARY/2**, when asked whether he knew of any Ukrainians in Paris who were working for the French IS, mentioned **ARCASSOWARY/28's** name and his name only. He added further that he has had nothing to do with the man for about the past 18 months. Two years ago, approximately, he wrote to **ARCASSOWARY/28** asking for information on emigre and Soviet activities in France. He received no answer. He then sent a follow-up letter by registered mail, asking that **ARCASSOWARY/28** clarify his position and activities. He also received no answer to that one. **ARCASSOWARY/2** hence has dropped all interest in **ARCASSOWARY/28**. **ARCASSOWARY/2** added that **ARCASSOWARY/28** seems to be heavily involved with the order of Masons in France. It will be recalled that **ARCASSOWARY/28** and **ARCHERMANIS/9** were not the best of friends and that the former, with more emotion than commonsense, tried to create the illusion that the latter is or was an SIS agent. Headquarters considers these vague accusations unsupported by adequate facts and tends to conclude that the source was, for reasons unknown, furthering a personal vendetta. At any rate, **ARCHERMANIS/9** now teaches at an American University and does only occasional literary piecework for the **ARCASSOWARIES**.
2. As you are probably aware, **ARDOGA/1** was the man who first recommended the **ARCASSOWARY/1** organization to **KURANK** way back in 1947. He is aware that contact was taken up per his suggestion. He is presumably unaware of specific developments since then, except for what he has heard from other emigres. **ARCASSOWARY/2** and **3** became aware in 1948 or 1949 that **ARDOGA/1** had been used as a source by **KURANK**. They approve of him, but since he is well-known among Ukrainians as a former Abwehr agent and later SIS agent, they have never tried to bring him into their organization. As an Abwehr agent during World War II, **ARDOGA/1** provided good tips to **ARCASSOWARY/2** regarding German anti-Ukrainian mobilities, planned arrests, etc.
3. **ARCASSOWARY/2's** efforts to jack up the reporting of the reference identity are consistent with his desire to keep abreast of events which bear on operational possibilities in Europe. **ARCASSOWARY/2** will probably be taking a trip to Europe during 1960 and will undoubtedly wish to stop in Paris to back up his long investments there.
4. Our ability to monitor passively the **ARCASSOWARY** complex in Paris via **ARDOGA/1** is appreciated, but should naturally continue to be handled in a manner which will not arouse the **ARCASSOWARIES'** suspicions.
