1. PI PROBLEMAN

- a. CS-3/436,924 dated 11 May 1960, based on a letter from the Ukraine deals with road and building construction in the Stanislay Oblast, Ukrain.
- b. ANGASSWARY/2, at our request, checked through his source and travel agencies in the New York area to find out if persons who left the USSR during WW II could still get visas. He found they could.
- c. PI requirements on the city of Lvov were given to ARCASSCHARY /2 who planned to interrogate a recent elderly female immigrant from Lvov via Foland. Results not yet received.

2. REDSKIN IN AND OVE

- a. Peter POTICIONAL, favorably assessed for REDGKIN activities in Sweden, decided he equid not accept the offer made to him by WE/1/6, since Uppsala did not provide a suitable curriculum. He would have been willing to go to Stockholm, but WE already had fulfilled their student REDEKIN needs there.
- b. Ostap STELMACH, an American citizen of Ukrainian birth now residing in Baltimore, is going to the USER this summer. He plans to visit his mother who is ill and living in the village of Enrumnian, licated between Lvov and Turnopol. AMEASSONERY/15 is in contact with MINIMACH and has offerred him advice regarding how best to get to his home village. Operational clearance is now pending on STELMACH. It is expected that a low-level REDEKIN piggy-back operation will evolve under AMEASSONARY/15 management.

- e. AMMANNAMI/15 travelled to Canada during the Memorial Day weekend to make a preliminary survey of MEDGKIN apportunities. He is writing up the results of his trip.
- A. Yadim ANUNCIPATELY, former Soviet Ukrainian evinning champ now living in New York, is being considered as an agent for contact operations during the Rose Clympies. Home traces are being run and, if need be, a direct approach to him can be made by CIA as soon as clearance is obtained. A/R has supplied some background information on ANUNCIPATELY s contacts with Soviet sublictus at the Melbourne Clympius and International Track Most in Philadelphia.
- e. Stephen GLYMIK, agent emplicate for a one month trip to the UcSSR, must have a 10-87 and GI Staff clearance. The latter currently is held up pending resolution by ______ office of alleged former payelso-sountin troubles.

3. MAILING COMPATIONS

2500 INVENATION BULLDING were mailed to the Union from eight countries during May.

4. BADTO

Two ananymous 15-minute broadcast scripts were prepared on the subject of the Summit collapse. ANDASSONARY/2 was asked to prepare these to have ready in the unlikely event that we could put them on the air. One script was good; the other dwell on the well-worn theme of "that gammater Khyvahobev and his Moscov satraps." The good erticle, written by ANDASSONARY/2 himself, will be included in the next INFORMATION BULLETIN.

5. OBUR

- a. ARGARDUARY/15 and 29's training continued.
- b. ARCANDOMATY/2 requested and we agreed:
 - 1. to give him addresses of Soviet diplomats living abroad to whom literature can be mailed.
 - R. to consider having him week a private audience with Khrushchev while the latter is in Yiemm. He feels he could worst Khrushchev in any debate on any political topic. If he gets a turndown, that too is of CA value, in his opinion. We deferred judgment on this.

c. ANCASSONARY/R submitted a draft of his proposed European itinerary. It lacked sufficient detail and was returned to him for elaboration.
