1. S. began his medical studies in Breslau, Germany during the WWII. Then continued them in Munich, Germany where from he emigrated to the United States.

Returned back to Munich and graduated from here with a medical degree in 1957. Then came back again to the States.

2. After the WW II S, was very active in black-marketeering and had some contacts with the Munich underworld in general.

3. S has contact with MIKE, Snu, - a driver of the USSR mission at the UN. Mike is supposed to be a Lithuanian, speaks Lithuanian, Russian, Ukrainian and English. S met him in his hospital in Astoria, New York where Mike brings some patients. S and Mike meet often in a bar or restaurant and S proposed to introduce Mike to one of our people.

SUBJECT: Teofila (Fila), FEDORIV, nee BZOVA, Poland

DATE: 30 June 1960

1. S went from Poland via Toronto, Canada on about 20 June 1960 to Edmonton, Canada to visit her brother-in-law who is living in Edmonton or in vicinity. She is going to return to Poland.

2. S is a very active and known former member of the OUN. She also is personally known to our people here, Her husband - Petro, FEDORIV, pseud. DALNYCH was chief of the Security Service (SB) of the CUN-UPA and as such member of Provid of Zakerzonya Kray. Caught by the Poles he was sentenced to death and hanged ( see "Wojskowy Przegląd Polityczny", No 1, 1959, "Walki z bandami UPA" by Ignacy Blum. gen. brygady, pp 3-30).

3. S was supposed to have been sentenced to 12 years and released in the course of an amnesty. After her release she went probably on a visit to Lviv or some other place in Ukraine and then came back to Poland.

4. Her friends in Philadelphia want her to stay for some time with them in New York.

5. It is very important for us to get in touch with her.

DATE: 30 June, 1950

1. S left by plane from New York on 24 June 1960 for Poland, and Ukraine in particular. He is going to visit Lviv and Tarnopol in Ukraine.

2. S is son of a Ukrainian catholic priest near Tarnopol. During the WW II attended the Ukrainian gymnasium ( grammar school) in Tarnopol, Ukraine.

3. S is personally known to Karl from the OUN. His date of return is kindly requested in order to enable Karl to contact him if possible.
