1. According to source of Subject report, the RAKHYNSKY Forest is located on the edge of the village of RAKHYNYA. RAKHYNYA is "the first little station stop" on the railroad which runs between DOLYNA and STANISLAV, about four kilometers from DOLYNA. Source said that although he would only be guessing by stating that the forest covered an area between 100 and 200 acres of land, it was a sizable area.
