SUBJECT: Voice of America

The following comments were made by two women, recent immigrants from the USSR now living in Winnipeg, Canada:

Both women stated they had listened to Voice of America broadcasts and expressed disappointment in the broadcast content. They told the reporting source that although Soviet Ukrainians listen to the Voice of America broadcasts, they criticize them and complain about them among themselves. They prefer BBC broadcasts. When leaving for the United States, they were asked by a local Ukrainian to ask those in the emigration to arrange for "better broadcasts regarding political matters not rubbish."
