3. To reduce some of the paper work and cable traffic arising from extensions of subsidies, it is requested that the new subsidy be for a six months period or a one year period. 1. I will inform L that:

a. B would like to meet L.

b. We have info to the effect that B would be interested in discussing possible unification between ZPUHVR and OUN/B.

c. Such proposal envisions a Foreign Minister post for L.

2. I will ask L:

a. In view of urgent operational necessity for an operational agreement, what in his opinion should be discussed at such conference?

b. Establishment of an overall operational staff devoid of politics.

c. What are the chances of reaching an agreement with B on developing operational unit for joint ops this spring - leaving out political problems for present?

d. Where and when such conferences could be held?

3. I will suggest that:

a. Desirability of reaching promptly a working operational agreement.

b. Laying aside internal politics and controversies on the future government of the Ukraine.

c. That a meeting take place in either Germany or London as soon as possible.

4. I will not be involved in discussing:

a. VOA

b. U. S. foreign policy

c. Future status of independent Ukrainian government

d. etc.
