- 1. Location of the training site.
- Cover for the trainees
- The training completion deadline of the program.

The training division confirmed a previous statement that the actual training phase (point 3 above) could be accomplished by the given deadline once point 1 and point 2 above were established. Some consideration was given to the feasibility of incorporating this particular program under Project, ELOFE. However, this proposal was unacceptable in that the first phase of the training program, namely the training and eventual airdrop of a small group before the fall of 1951, could not be accomplished under project ELBRE. Although the Guerrilla Warfare training program is similar in some respects to the ELOPE project, it is doubtful whether the ELOPE facilities are suitable or if they can be available for thes activity is A sell limits.
