This is a underground airfield, and according to information Subject received from local inhabitants, is of extraordinary great dimension. 2 years ago there was a sort of panic among the airfield personnel, which is composed exclusively of Russians, and some Eastern Ukrainians. Arrests were made and some of the personnel were sent out home. There was a rumor circulating in the area that someone from among the personnel has "sold" plans of the airfield to Americans.

2. In the area of DELATIN, Stanislav/blast, in the direction toward the mountains (Subject was unable to give more specific location) a number of villages have been resettled; the area was enclosed by wire and a high fence a parameter standard There is a rumor that manganese ore is being mined there. The local population who do not have any access to that are could establish only one fast that many trucks z filled with dirt came sut every day from that area unload the dirt and return empty. Subject of remarked "either they really mine something there are they build something under ground". Subject was not in that area herself; she only herd about it from other people.

She also has heard that "Beyond Boryslav" (Drohobych area) there is also such a denied area where villages have been resettled, the local population has no access to it and something "secret is going on there".

The Soviets were alarmed after the U-2 was shot down. At that there was a great movement of military and a very big mass of rocket transports and of other secret arms to the area of Dobromil, in the Carpathians on the Polish border.

In the area of Delyatin there is a forbidden zone, where nobody can live. The enroute truckdrivers who bring in some kind of material are changed on/the/way/several times and return with empty trucks.

In the large electric lamp factory in Lvov there is one department manned only by Russians, and they are strictly controlled.
