George SHUMOVSKY, born ca. 1900, is an archaeologist and technograph. He worked with the French in Bamako, Mali, on the construction of a museum. He was there for about 10 years following WWII. He is acquainted with the president of Mali....."very good friends" according to AECASSOWARY/15. He supposedly knows many others in high positions in Mali and maintains correspondence with some of them. He is acquainted with some of the people in Mali who have studied in Moscow.

Subject turned over reports on his explorations on minerals, including bauxites, to the French, but did not report to them his findings on his oil explorations. He presently is employed by a firm engaged in mailing parcels to the Soviet Union.

Subject is married but has no children.

Arsen SHUMOVSKY, Subject's brother, ca. 75, attended the Welders Conference in New York in April at which time he had contact with Soviets at the conference.
