1. In late 1960, Subject arrived in the United States from Poland as the wife of fmu SIKORA, a United States citizen living in Cleveland, Ohio. Subject, who formerly was the wife of an officer (fmu ONYSHEVYCH aka ONYSZKIEWICZ) in the UPA (Ukrainian Insurgent Army) in the Ukraine, had been imprisoned in Poland for eight years. She was released in ca. 1958-1959 and all documents concerning her trial and imprisonment were released by the Polish courts, translated into English and submitted to the United States Embassy in Warsaw prior to her immigration to the United States.

2. We should appreciate your obtaining the documents concerning Subject's case from the Embassy in Warsaw as they would be of interest to this office.
