As you are probably aware, newspapers have run stories on troubles in most of the cities mentioned and, of course, the riots have been subjects for KUNOLF exploitation. Taganrog, Tuapse and Batumi, however, are new areas and of particular interest. Headquarters would also like any details which become available on any of the more generally covered areas mentioned above. There is interest, too, even when no details are available, in how recently people have been discussing the uprisings and under what circumstances the subject was initiated.
