Bad Harvest.

Excerpt from a letter dated 26 July 1962 from Kolomeya, West Ukraine:

" We expect and are very afraid of a bad harvest. This will be followed by worsening of living conditions."

Bulgarians are less fond of Russian.

Excerpt from a letter of O.DUCHYMINSKA dtd 20 July 1962:

" We have correspondence (on behalf of our museum) with Czecks, Poles, and Bulgarians. Recently my friend ( widow of CHEREMSHYNA - Natalia KARPIUK -SEMANIUK ) went to Bulgaria. They asked her as consultant . Her husband's works will be soon published in Bulgarian. They translated already some works of Lesia Ukrainka, Shevchenko, and others. Also a collection of Ukrainian classic prose is ready in Bulgarian. My friend contributes all the time to Bulgarian journal "Slavs". She was very much welcomed. What they liked most that she spoke Ukrainian and not Russian. She spoke only Ukrainian and no Russian at all.

She also put flowers on Drahomanov's grave.  
Then she visited our known sculptor and architect TARASHCHUK.  
She was in Bulgaria for three weeks."
