1. Subject headed the 9 members Soviet delegation to the International Conference on Nuclear Structure at Kingston, Canada, that lasted from 29 August to 3 Sep 1960. His appearance was about 55, 6', long slim face, grey hair, rather rough manners; Ukrainian, married. Beside him there were 3 other Ukrainians, two of them from the Ukraine, and one from Leningrad too.

2. As the head of the Delegation, Subject gave his interview to CBC Montreal in Russian at which he made some quite strong statements contrary to the interview given <sup>in Ukrainian</sup> by his friend from Kiev, Academician Prof PASICHNYK, Mytrofan Vasilovich. According to R both seemed to be conscious Ukrainians and Subject used to joke about his playing the role of "elder brother". Both were also interested in Ukrainian life in Canada and were quite impressed by it.

3. The Report on Subject and his friends was submitted still in Nov 1960 together with "official photograph" of participants of the Kingston Conference.
