1. Born in BERNI L, Poland of Jewish parents; in 1939 he was an electrical engineer; the accident at the Lviv Polytechnical Institute. 1941 fled to Central Asia and early 1942 was drafted for service with the Red Army.

2. Decorated for bravery in action on the North Caucasian battlefield and following the Operation Blue Nystrol OSS in 1943 he was transferred to the First Armored Army and served as a captain and Operations Officer at Brigade Hqs of the 64th Armored Brigade of the Red Army.

3. Wounded in the battle of RASNOUL he spent two months at the 912th Military Hospital in POGOROV, and after his discharge from there, transferred in 19 to TROD L. in USSR, as First Staff Section Officer (Orders and Training) of Col. MA LEMENOV's "Operativnaya grupa" (Operational Task Force). Since then till 1949 he was actively involved in fighting against the UFA.

4. Aug 1944 - early 1946 in action against the UFA in the Ukraine. He took part in a major campaign conducted in the beginning (Aug 1944) by General Kyrill MOSKALEV, Chief of Staff of Soviet Airborne and Parachute Forces who headed at that time an Army Group on the Ukrainian front. (15 years later Gen. Moskalenko became Chief of Staff of Soviet Airborne Forces). Other units participating in the campaign of 1944 the other "Operativnaya grupe", those under command of Col. SKOVOROTSOV and BADAYEV, respectively; two cavalry divisions of the First Guards Corps, two motorized infantry brigades of Kabanov's First Armored Army, 154th Inf. Division (which helped to break through the German line), plus various Soviet guerrillas under Col. Boris B. V. and Lt. Col. KOTLYV in 1945, militia units and village "Kotiblets". Altogether about 4,000 troops and police.

5. Early 1946 transferred to the Police NKVD (Internal Security Corps) with

the rank of Major and served as senior adviser to the Military Commandant of DANIK-
District, where he continued to fight against the CPA.

6. 1951 he immigrated to Israel. Married in 1952, had two daughters and one
son. At the present employed as a supervisor at an electrical plant near HAIFA.
