1. On 17 Feb 1964 Subject visited A and B f om 20.00 to 01.00 hrs. His formal purpose was to discuss the matter of eventual establishment of the Institute of Folitical Sciences at the American Ukrainian Institute in New York, N.Y. (DJUSS' Institute). It was A's impression, however, that he wanted also to learn as much as possible about Metropolit SLIPYI, in particular what he told her whan A saw Mtropolit in Rome, Italy. A explained that she saw Metropolit for a very short period and he said nothing of interest.

- 2. Subject informed A about the projected answer-letter to the 34 lietrary men in Kiev who had written on occasion of Shevmhenko's celebrations in Washington, D. D. to Ukrainian immigrants. He was strongly in favor of answering their letter positively. Subject also praised A for her "courageous approach" to the situation in the Ukraine.
- 3. Subject expressed also willingness to help A in amanging with "Samopomish" (Self-Reliance) an eventaul financing of one of her books.
