1. Subject is teacher of English in Kharkov, Ukr SSR. Quite unsympathetic "though tries to smile". Born in 1929 in a village in Kharkov's Obl, 5'9", 160 lbs, dark complexion, wears glasses, black hair; Ukrainian. Source met Subject in the lobby of Sage Hall on Friday, Aug 7, 64 at 11:00 AM. She seemed to be the leader of the group and one of "backstreet boys". As soon as Source was introduced she took him aside and took him to suit. Finally, she went to her room and brought with her a folder "Chernivtsi, Halychod, Poltava" - an Entourist prospect in English. Later on when KOVALCHUK came Subject told him that [unclear] was born in the States and his parents had come here to earn money. This seemed quite strange to Source as he never told her anything about himself. When parting Subject told Source that he hoped he learned from her something new about the [unclear] near Ukrainian was very poor.

2. Subject was telling Source well about Shevchenko celebrations in Ukraine, special publications and memorial books recently appeared in Kiev on this occasion, etc. She did not comment when Source told her about [unclear] demonstrations in Washington, D.C. Subject did not tell anything substantial and her talk was restricted to [unclear] information, info in the United States, etc.
