1. Subject is Kazakh, "professor" of English, born in 1925, 5'6, black hair combed down short, looks very oriental with quite dark complexion. Source met Subject on 7 Aug 1964 in the morning and evening at the Sage House. He seemed to be very frightened and cautious. Was quite interested in living conditions in the States but avoided political topics. Only once, in the evening, on 7 Aug 1964, in presence of Kovalenko and another Russian who called Ukrainian a dialect of Russian, Subject vehemently protested that this was not true and praised Ukrainian as a developed, history-old, cultured language.

2. Subject stayed mostly in company of KAMALOVA, Anvara.
