SUBJECT - Fm KRAVCHUK, Canadian Student in Kiev

ACTION: Pass to SHABOVA

1. You may pass the following information to SHABOVA but please explain that we will be unable to provide additional information because of the sensitivity of the sources:

A Ukrainian emigre in the United States, who has contacts with Soviet officials in the United States and who is suspected of collaboration with Soviet authorities, told a usually reliable but sensitive source, following the former's visit to the Soviet Union earlier this summer (1961), that he had learned that the daughter of Fm KRAVCHUK (KRAVCHUK, KRAVCHUK) of Canada had been in Kiev for one or two years and that she has returned to Canada "ready to work." He added the comment that he knows the Soviets do not invest money for nothing.

2. It is possible that the Fm KRAVCHUK may be identical with Peter KRAVCHUK, Recording Secretary of the Association of United Canadian Ukrainians.

3. We would be interested in receiving any information on Miss KRAVCHUK's stay in Kiev and on whether she has been assigned to work with the Young Communist League or with one of the front organizations.
