## ACTION REPORTED

a) By Field

1. **ANDRUMMER 4**, editor of the Ukrainian newspaper "Ukrainsky Samostiynik" and political leader of the OUN<sub>2</sub> (splinter group which separated from OUN/Bandera in 1953 and which has worked since then in close contact with ZP/UHVE), died on 12 October 1957 of a heart attack while on his way to work. **VASYL MARKUS**, who currently resides in Paris and works with the "Ukrainian Encyclopedia" was asked to complete the editorial work for the October issue of the newspaper. In all probability, MARKUS will be retained as the new editor of the "Ukrainsky Samestiynik".

2. As of 1 Sep 1957, the above-mentioned newspaper has been published on a monthly basis in journal format. Under the new editorial policy, the paper will publish scholarly articles on the following topics dealing with the USSR and the Ukrainian SSR: Politics, Culture, Youth Problems, Religion, Economics, Mode of Life. The paper will also contain sections dealing with the Ukrainian emigration and general news comments.

b) By Headquarters:

1. Radio Tapes No. 97, 98, 99, and 100 were prepared and submitted for transmission via Radio PYREX. Radio PYREX reports that 12 hours and 28 minutes of transmitter time was expended for 42 runs of the AERODYNAMIC program in August. On 13 August 57, this program was granted an additional daily play at 1830Z hours.

2. The "Information Bulletin" No. 9, October issue, was completed and distributed. PP materials for the preparation of Ukrainian broadcasts at Radio NACIONAL were also prepared and submitted during this period.

3. In Sept-Oct 1957, the **AM BEEHIVE** group helped finance the visit to Poland of a West-German professor of Ukrainian origin. The professor had visited Ukrainians in Poland in 1956 and had maintained contact with them in the interim. While in Poland he made visits to Ukrainians in Warsaw, Lublin, Kracow, Peremyshl and other cities where he talked

to Ukrainian intellectuals, professors and students about the Ukrainian problems in Poland. While in Krakow, he was able to make contact with a man from the Ukrainian SSR and obtain information on Lviv and other parts of the Ukraine. The following reports were obtained from the professor by AECASSOWARY 2 and relayed to interested offices and sent to SR/Reports for possible dissemination:

- a) Information on the Situation of the Ukrainian Minority in Poland
- b) Situation of the Ukrainians in the Ukrainian SSR and USSR
- c) Situation of the Ukrainians in Siberia
- d) Information on personnel in charge of the "Ukrainian Social-Cultural Society" in Warsaw

4. Approximately 300 copies of the English magazine have been distributed to AECASSOWARY representatives in Argentina, Brazil, Australia, France, Germany, Great Britain, Canada, Switzerland, and Sweden. The representatives have been instructed to distribute these magazines to individuals and institutions in their country who are interested in the problem of Communist imperialism. At the same time approximately 1000 copies of the Polish magazine have been sent to libraries and individuals in the following countries: Afghanistan, Burma, Ceylon, China (Formosa), India, Egypt, Iran, Iraq, Indonesia, Pakistan, Philippines, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Syria, Thailand, Turkey, Lebanon, Israel, France, Germany, Great Britain, Austria, Australia, Belgium, New Zealand, Ireland, Norway, Spain, Sweden.

b. PENDING ACTION:

Plans have been made to increase the number of tapes prepared for transmission over Radio PYREX from 4 to 8. AECASSOWARY 2 stated that this could be initiated in December.
