ACTION REPORTED

a) By Fields

1. ANDRUMMER 4, editor of the Ukrainian sewspaper "Ukrainsky Samostivalk" and political leader of the OUNs (splinter group which separated from OUN/Banders in 1953 and which has worked since then in close contaut with 2P/UHVE), died on 12 October 1957 of a heart attack while on his way to work. Varyb-MARKUS, who currently resides in Paris and works with the "Ukrainian Encyclopedia" vas asked to complete the editorial work for the Saturder issue of the newspaper. In all probability, MARKUS will be retained as the new editor of the "Ukrainsky Samestiynik".

2. As of 1 Sep 1957, the above mentioned newspaper has been published on a monthly basis in journal format. Under the new editorial policy, the paper will publish scholarly articles on the following topics dealing with the USSR and the Ukrainian SSR: Politics, Culture, Youth Problems, Religion, Economics, Mede of Life. The paper will also contain sections dealing with the Ukrainian emigration and general news comments.

1) By Headquarters:

1. Radio Tapes No. 97, 98, 99, and 100 were prepared and submitted for transmission via Radie PYREX. Radie FYREX reports that 12 hours and 28 minutes of transmitter time was expended for 42 runs of the AERODYNAMIC perceptan in August. On 13 August 57, this program was granted an additional daily play at 1830Z hours.

2. The "Information Bulletin" No. 9, October issue, was completed and distributed. PP materials for the preparetics of Ukrainian broadcasts at Radie NACIONAL were also prepared and submitted during this period.

3. In Sept-Oct 1957, the AK BREHIVE group helped finance the visit in Poland of a West-German professor of Ukreinian origin. The professor had visited Ukrainians in Peland in 1956 and had usintwined contact with them in the interim. While in Poland he made visits to Ukrainians in Warsaw, Lublin, Kracow, Peremyshi and other cities where he talked

While in Kracow, he was able to make context with a man from the Ukrainian SSR and obtain information on Latv and other parts of the Ukraine. The following reparts were obtained from the professor by AECASSOWART 2 and relayed to interatual offices and sent to SR/Reports for possible disseminations
