occ: Shipper

1. Subject met an agent of the Soviet KGB last year in JAKARTA ^{fnu} / MUZYCHENKO first name unknown. MUZYCHENKO works as shipper in JAKARTA. (head of shipping) and has at his disposal control of all incoming and outgoing ships in Jakarta. ^{cit USSR} Jakarta, Indonesia

KGB officer in contact with Bohdan Stezko

2. Subject was approached by MUZYCHENKO on the pretext that they are both Ukrainians in a strange land and have many things in common. Subject was invited to a dinner, and accepted. This invitation led to another (although there were 2-3 meetings) At these meetings MUZYCHENKO tried to convince subject to return home to Ukraine, that he would be given a good job with high pay.

3. At the second or third meeting (subject is not sure.) MUZYCHENKO asked him if he would supply him with information about American installations, and military bases in U.S.A. Subject refused and avoided M.

4. STEZKO, Bohdan : ^{DOB CA 1936} ^{USSR} Born in (Ukraine) lived in Boston with parents. Aged 30-31. Single, graduated from high school, left home after high school. Travelled to Indonesia privately where he engaged in odd jobs. Was told (advised) to leave Indonesia because of political situation in 1964 (early 1965). Subject is pleasant, likes to talk about his experiences in Indonesia. Can be considered a bohemian by his dress and manners.
