SUBJECT: Tanara KOWALSKI, Employee in Office of Polish Prime Minister

1. The following which is being submitted for your information was submitted to this office by a confidential source who obtained it from an American citizen (sub-source) who visited Poland in the summer of 1965. The subsource lived in the home of the Subject for a few days during her visit in Warsaw.

2. According to the subsource, the Subject, who is about 50 years of age, is "chief of the Hungarian Desk in the office of the Polish Prime Minister." The Subject reportedly frequently travels to Hungary and other satellite countries. She is single and lives in Warsaw with her 80 year old mother who is a Russian. Her father, now deceased, was a school teacher from Volynia in the Ukraine. The Subject studied French at the Sorbonne previous to 1939. Besides Polish, French and Russian, she also speaks German. She is in correspondence with Professor Pavlo SZUMOWSKI of Paris.
