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Remarks: This is not the first report we have received of this kind. AECASSOWARY/29 reported several months ago that Der Spiegel had carried an article in which it was stated that the Chicoms were beaming Uke-language radio programs to Ukrainians in Siberia. Dr. Yaroslav Bilensky, an emigre, wrote Spiegel, inquiring about the source of this info and was told that it was obtained from the Ukrainian Information Service, published by Yaroslav Stetsko (ABW and Banderist). The UIS also carried an article to the effect that Uke-language broadcasts were being heard in Siberia. A/29 is running down the publications(UIS). At about the same time as the above there were rumors in Munich and New York emigre circles that Stetsko and his Banderists had been approached by			
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the Chicoms in London. The latter offered to collaborate with Ukrainian emigres in anti-Soviet propaganda. These rumors were short-lived and unconfirmed.

Attached also is some material on the same subject from the pro-Banderist press in Toronto.

Soviet Ukrainians with whom AECASSOWARY agents have had contacts are well aware of the possibility of a Chicom-Ukrainian arrangement against Moscow, but, even when maintaining their Ukrainian nationalist aspirations, they deny any interest in collaborating with the Chicoms. They say it would be impossible for Soviet Ukrainians to side with the Chicoms, because the latter are irresponsible and warlike. These, of course, are Soviet Ukrainians masquerading as nationalists (UN officials, etc.). What the attitude of real Uke nationalists would be, I don't know, but I doubt that they would be interested either. Too high a price, dealing with the Chicoms. No one believes that they are responsible. However, despite this, if there were some real possibility for gain, not possible under current conditions in the USSR, Uke nationalists might be tempted.

Attached also is a Reuters report on Sinkiang. It might be that the Chicoms, in their operational schemes, have somehow united these two factors (Ukraine and Sinkiang) in a ploy. What they appear to be doing against the Ukraine, they accuse the Soviets of doing in Sinkiang. Might be truth on both sides.

Please return the attached.

All in all a fascinating subject. Who said nationalism was dead?!

(EXCEPTS) MOSCOW--COMMUNIST CHINA HAS ACCUSED THE KREMLIN OF CONSTANT SABOTAGE AND SUBVERSION IN CHINESE SINKIANGS, WHICH BORDER ON SOVIET KAZAKHSTAN, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY. THE CHARGE CAME IN A PEKING RADIO RUSSIAN-LANGUAGE BROADCAST, THE TEXT OF WHICH WAS MADE AVAILABLE HERE TODAY.

IT SAID RUSSIA HAD DESCRIBED THE HUGE ARID TERRITORY AS A CHINESE COLONY AND TRIED TO SEPARATE IT FROM THE REST OF THE COUNTRY.

CITING A SPEECH BY SAIFUDIN, WHO HEADS THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT, THE BROADCAST CHARGED RUSSIA TRIED TO INCITE THE PEOPLE OF THE AREA TO OPPOSE THE CHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY.

THIS WAS THE FIRST OFFICIAL REPORT OF TROUBLE IN THE HEROIC BORDER REGION SINCE SEPTEMBER, 1962, WHEN THE SOVIET PRESS REPORTED REFUGEES CROSSING INTO THE SOVIET UNION.

SPEAKING AT RECENT CELEBRATIONS TO MARK 10 YEARS OF THE SINKIANG-HIGHUR AUTONOMOUS REGION, SAIFUDIN COMPARED RUSSIAN AIMS WITH ATTEMPTS OF TSARIST RUSSIA AND 19TH CENTURY BRITAIN TO SPLIT CHINA. HE ACCUSED MOSCOW OF SPREADING "UNMIXED NONSENSE" IN SAYING THAT "SINKIANG IS A COLONY OF CHINA AND THAT A POLICY OF FRAUD AND NATIONAL DISCRIMINATION IS CONDUCTED IN THE REGION."

HE CHARGED "KHRUSHCHEV REVISIONISTS," A COMMON CHINESE TERM FOR THE SOVIET LEADERSHIP, WITH TRYING TO "SPLIT OFF SINKIANG FROM THE GREAT MOKTLAND... TO INCITE THE PEOPLE OF SINKIANG TO OPPOSE THE CHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY."

КИТАЙ Б'Є МОСКВУ НАЦІОНАЛЬНИМ ПИТАННЯМ

Часопис „Ді Помор'є Шей-тунг" інформує, що в другій половині вересня ц. р. українці, які працюють у відділах Суспільно-культурного Товариства (УСКТ) в різних частинах Польщі, дістали листи, що в них якнайгостріше засуджується депортація українців СРСР до Союзом. Ці листи мали печатки різних поштових урядів у Варшаві. Правдоподібно, що їх вислало червоно-китайське посольство, або підлеглі йому установи. Надавцем листів була невідома досі „Комуністична Ліга для людських і національних прав", з офісом у Пекіні.

Газета твердить, що в одному Штеттні одержало понад 200 таких листів. Польська поліція домагається, щоб листи були їй передані, але досі „знайдено" тільки тузень таких листів. Зміст листів став відразу широко відомим на Помор'ї і Шлеску. Польські комуністи не від-

важуються одверто виступати проти цієї китайської акції. Червоний Китай не обмежив своєї акції теренами сучасної Польщі. В Пінську комуністичні чинники одержали подібні листи з вимогою гостро протиставитися русифікації, з запереченням, що Китай виступатиме в обороні прав українців. Якщо Україна хоче бути самостійною державою, — пишеться в листах. — і український народ вимагатиме цього своїм волевиявленням, то ці домагання також будуть підтримані. Одночасно в листах до поляків, що ще живуть на західно-українських землях, зазначено, що всі громадяни мають одержати право вирішувати, чи їхня батьківщина має либати при СРСР, чи повернутися до Польщі.

В усіх листах згадується також про вимордування польських офіцерів москалями у Катині і закликається вимагати справедливої карі для справжніх винуватців цього злочину, подібно як це діється на Ашшурському процесі у Франкфурті. (За „Шляхом Перемоги" з 25. 10. ц. р.).

CHINA STRIKES MOSCOW WITH THE NATIONALITY ~~REVISION~~ PROBLEM

The newspaper The Pomershe Tseitung informs that in the second-half of September of this year Ukrainians who work in branches of the Social-Cultural Society (UCKT) in various areas of Poland have received letters in which the deportation of Ukrainians by the Soviets is most severely criticized. These letters carried post marks of various postal institutions in Warsaw. The letters probably were mailed by the Red Chinese Embassy or organizations under its jurisdiction. The sponsor of the letters was the previously unknown "Communist League for Human and National Rights", the center of which is in ~~PEKING~~ Peking.

The newspaper claims that in Stettin alone more than 200 such letters were received. The Polish police have demanded that the letters be turned over to them but so far only about a dozen such letters have been "found". The contents of these letters became widely known in Silesia and Pomerania. Polish Communists don't have the nerve to openly oppose this Chinese action.

Red China has not limited its action to the territory of present day Poland. In Pinsk, Communist elements received similar letters calling for strong opposition to Russification with promises that China will take steps to protect the rights of Ukrainians. If Ukraine wants to be an independent nation -- the letters state -- and the Ukrainian people will demand this by virtue of their expressions of will, then these demands will also be supported. At the same time in letters to Poles who still live on Western Ukrainian territory, it is indicated that all citizens will be given the right to determine whether their fatherland is to be left with the USSR or returned to Poland.

Mention is also made in all the letters of the murder of Polish officers by Moscovites in Katyn and just punishment is demanded for all those responsible for this crime in ~~the same~~ a manner similar to the Oswiecim trials in Frankfurt.
