L. According to our Source in Paris and as confirmed by Uncle's friend in Melnyk Organization in this country, T. BIDNYK was arrested by Surete on 10 Feb 1967 at his address - 6 Square du Roche, Paris 8 -e on charges of espionage.

BIDNYK is Ukrainian, aged approx. 55-60, a close friend of Borys Vitishynsky present actual editor of Shlakk peremohy in Munich , Germany, active member of Z CH OUN. He was also known as the SB-chief for France. Before WW II BIDNYK was reportedly red and belonged to cummunist organization in 1966 he allegedly planned to repatriate to Ukraine and that time should have made contacts with Soviet Mission in Paris. Shortly after that he became any adamant adherent of Z CH OUN.

2. GUDZIY Sonia Ivanivna, nee VOVK, aged 37, Ukrainian, of Lvov, Ukrainian SSR arrived in Feb 1967 on a visit to her father VOVK of Windham, N.Y.

Please check on how she came to this country. According to GUDZIY Joseph of 255 Washington Ave., Clifton, N.J. she is restricted in her movements to 25 mile radius, is his sister-in-law, and is employed in some physico-math. research in Lvov.

Sonia could come to this country either as GUDZIY or under her maiden name - VOVK.

VOVK of Windhan, N. Y. is often visited by members of Soviet Warninger Mission to the U.N. who use to spend their summer weekends at his house.

3. According to our Source in Frankfurt, Germany, RUDENKO Gregori, third Secretary of Sov. Embassy in Bonn had been transferred to Kiev and appointed chief of Protokol at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ukr SSR. The information was obtained from Rudenko's colleagues.
