SUBJECT: Visit of Nikolai PODGORNY at the Vatican

1. During the recent visit of Nikolai PODGORNY to Rome. Pope Paul discussed with him matters concerning reestablishment of Roman Catholic (Latin Rite) diocese in the Soviet Union. The matter concerning reestablishment of the Ukrainian Catholic (or Unate) Church was not considered. On the contrary, as one of the conditions for further negotiations with the Vatican, PODGORNY demanded liquidation of the Ukrainian Catholic Small Seminary in Rome. The source said there are indeed certain circles in the Vatican inclined to sacrifice (on the surface) the Uniate Church, in an effort to obtain from Moscow maximum privileges for the Latin Rite Church, and at the same time secretly to strengthen the Uniate Church to be retained in a sleeper status. In this respect, for bargaining purposes in their negotiations with Moscow, the Vatican plans to emphasize the statue of Cardinal Yosip Yosip SLIPTY vis-a-vis the Vatican. It was assumed that it was with this in mind, that the Vatican instigated the plans Cardinal SLIPPY has to purchase the Small Seminary from the Selesian Fathers and have it subordinated to himself. The Vatican could then disclaim any legal rights to the seminary.

2. The Reverend Myroslav MARUSYN, Secretary to Archbishop Ivan BUCHKO, was PODGORNY's official guide during PODGORNY's visit to the Vatican Museum. Vatican officials instructed Reverend MARUSYN to introduce himself to PODGORNY as the secretary of Cardinal SLIPYY, and to speak to PODGORNY only in Ukrainian. PODGORNY spoke Ukrainian to Father MARUSYN. It was not known what all PODGORNY discussed with MARUSYN because immediately following his report to his superiors at the Vatican, MARYSYN was sworn to keep his conversation with PODGORNY secret.
